**NOTICE**

Applications are invited from suitable candidates for one post each of President in the District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission – I (post vacant) & District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission-II (vacancy will arise after 17.2.2022), U.T., Chandigarh on whole time basis established under the Consumer Protection Act, 2019.

**Eligibility Criteria: -**

As per rule 4 of the Consumer Protection (Qualification for appointment, method of recruitment, procedure of appointment, term of office, resignation and removal of the President and Members of the State Commission and District Commission) Rules 2020 which are made under the provisions the Consumer Protection 2019, described as under: -

4(1) A person shall not be qualified for appointment as President, unless he/she is or has been, or is qualified to be a District Judge.

All other terms and conditions of the appointment shall be governed by the Consumer Protection Act, 2019 as well as the Consumer Protection (Qualification for appointment, method of recruitment, procedure of appointment, term of office, resignation and removal of the Presidents and members of the State Commission and District Commission) Rules, 2020 available at website [www.chdfood.gov.in](http://www.chdfood.gov.in).

**Tenure: -**

The appointment shall be on whole time basis for a term of 4 years or up to the age of 65 years, whichever is earlier and as per provisions of Consumer Protection (Qualification for appointment, method of recruitment, procedure of appointment, term of office, resignation and removal of the President and Members of the State Commission and District Commission) Rules 2020 which are made under the provisions the Consumer Protection 2019.

**Other Important Information: -**

1. The applicants are required to submit their applications in the prescribed form which is annexed as Annexure- I.
2. The Applicants are required to furnish copies of their ten best judgments/other judicial orders passed by them along with their application form.
3. Selection of the President in District Commission will be made by the Selection Committee prescribed in the Rule 6 of the Consumer Protection (Qualification for appointment, method of recruitment, procedure of appointment, term of office, resignation and removal of the Presidents and Members of the State Commission and District Commission) Rules, 2020 which are made under the provisions of the Consumer Protection Act 2019.

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4. Salary will be paid to the appointed President in District Commission as per Chandigarh Consumer Protection (salary, allowances and conditions of service of President and Members of the State Commission and District Commission) Rules, 2021.
5. Every appointment of a President in District Commission shall be subject to submission of a certificate of physical fitness signed by a Civil Surgeon or District Medical Officer to his/her medical fitness.
6. Before appointment, the selected candidate shall have to furnish an undertaking that he does not and will not have any such financial or other interest as is likely to affect prejudicially his functions as such President in District Commission.

### Oaths of office and secrecy: -

Every person appointed to be a President, before entering upon his office make and subscribe to an oath of office and secrecy in Forms I and II annexed to Rules 2020 *ibid*.

### Declaration of Financial and other interest: -

A President, before entering upon his office, declare his assets, and his liabilities and other interests.


### Disqualifications: -

A person shall be disqualified for appointment as a President in District Commission, if he: -

- i. has been convicted and sentenced to imprisonment for an offence which involves moral turpitude; or
- ii. has been adjudged as an insolvent; or
- iii. is of unsound mind and stands so declared by a competent court, or
- iv. has been removed or dismissed from the service of the State Government or Central Government or a body Corporate owned or controlled by such Government; or
- v. has, in the opinion of the State Government, such financial or other interest as is likely to prejudicially affect his functions as the President.

Applications complete in all respects with requisite documents attached must reach in the office of the Joint Secretary, Department of Consumer Affairs, Chandigarh Administration, U.T., Secretariat, Sector-9, Chandigarh, latest by 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2021 by 5.00 P.M. It is made clear that the candidates must apply as per the format given below, failing which their application will not be entertained. The applications received after the last date of receipt of applications, for any reason, will be rejected and the candidates will not be called for interview. Any application found incomplete in any manner, would be rejected in scrutiny and no intimation regarding the same shall be sent to applicant.
